A *tag* is a small paper on an item you might buy. It tells you the price.

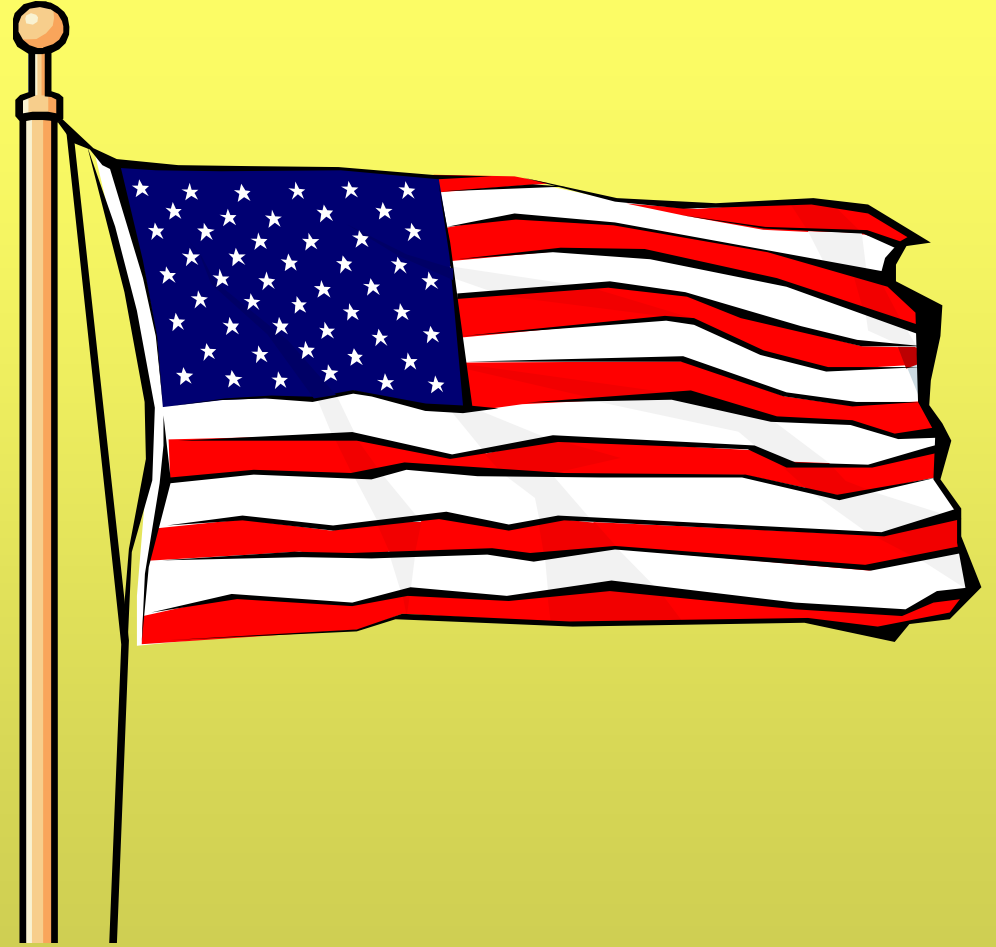


wag
