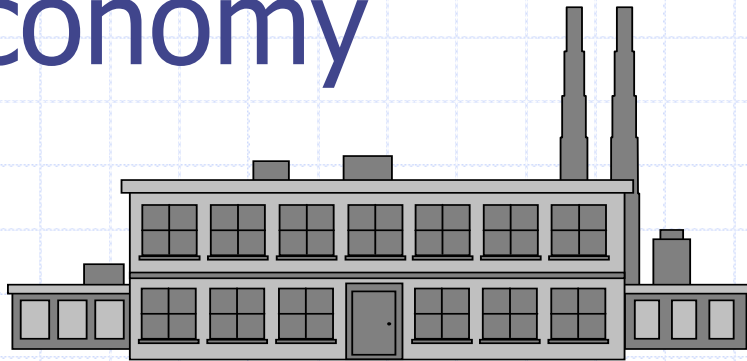

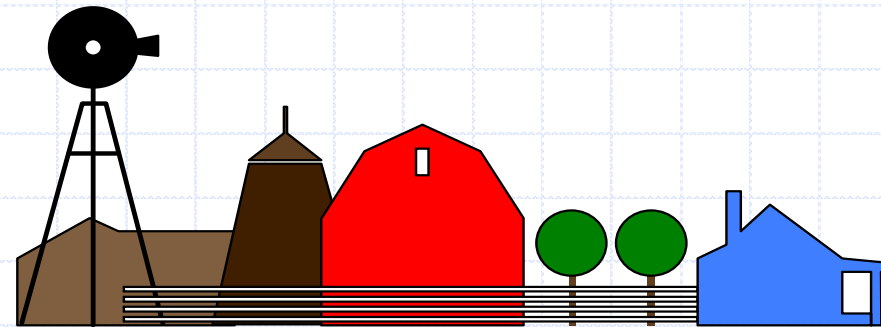

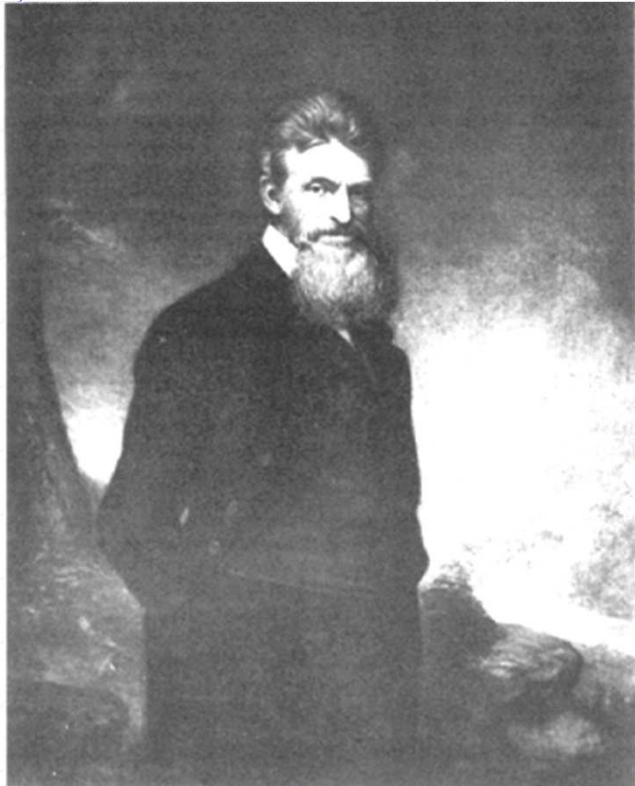
Who established a secret route to the North used by escaped slaves?

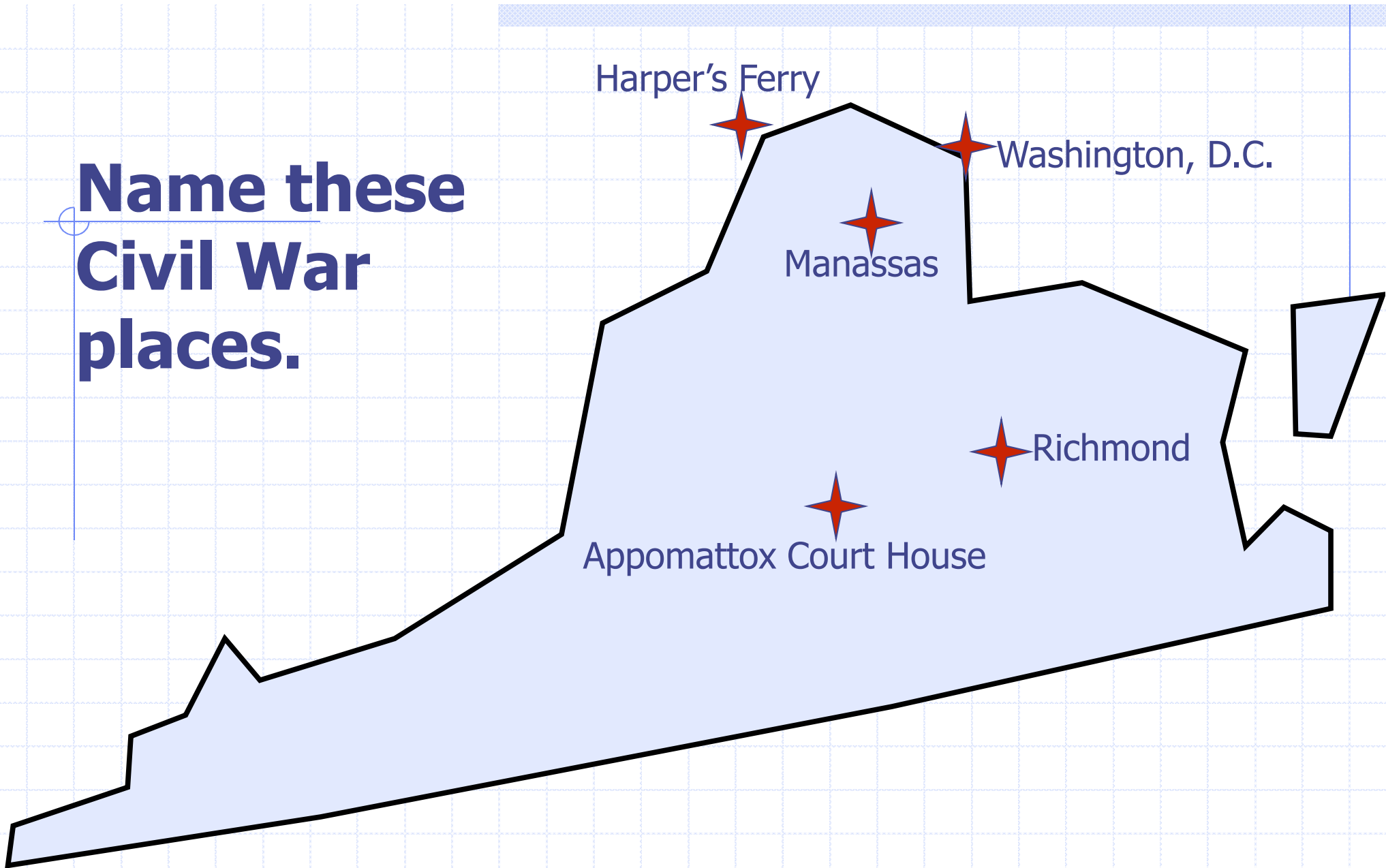
