

Roland Park Area Middle School Social Events

Social Activity Guidelines

The following guidelines for Middle School Social Events have been agreed upon by the six Roland Park area middle schools.

1. **Drop Off and Pick Up:** Students should be dropped off by parents at 7:30 p.m. and picked up by parents at the conclusion of the activity at 9:30 p.m. One half hour after the beginning of the activity, no new arrivals will be admitted. After a student or guest enters the building, he or she will not be allowed to leave and re-enter. A student who wishes to leave must call his or her parents and be picked up by them. If a student is asked to leave, parents will be notified and requested to pick up the student. Parents should make sure that their son or daughter knows where to contact them by telephone.

2. **Tickets:** Admission is only by tickets purchased in advance. No tickets will be sold at the door for any reason. Lost tickets must be replaced at the student's home school by the purchase of a new ticket. Students should not be dropped off without tickets; there will be **no tickets sold at the door**.

Only students at the host school may invite guests, one guest per student. The host school will make a list of invited guests and have this list at the door.

3. **Dress Code:** Clothing should be comfortable, casual and respectful. Specifically,

- a. Rubber soled shoes are required and must stay on all night.
- b. No tube tops and no low-cut tops.
- c. Midriffs must be covered and underwear must not be visible.
- d. No ripped or torn clothes.
- e. No clothing with inappropriate writing or images.

The chaperones reserve the right to determine inappropriate attire and behavior. Students may be asked to change or to leave the event.

4. **Backpacks and Sleepover Bags** will be kept in a separate place, inaccessible to students during the mixer. Chaperones reserve the right to inspect bags.
